

Publishing agreement for electronic publication of a student thesis via LiU E-Press

Linköping University Electronic Press (LiU E-Press) offers all students (at undergraduate and advanced levels) at Linköping University the possibility to e-publish their student thesis (essay or academic paper) in DiVA, unless there are copyright or confidentiality reasons for not doing so. Collected data may also be published as a supplement to the student thesis. This Agreement between the Author, identified below (in relevant cases, the term Author can refer to a collective of authors) regulates the publication of the work identified below including any associated collected data (and henceforth referred to as the Student thesis). By signing the Agreement, the Author agrees to "Terms of publication when publishing electronically via LiU E-Press" (Dnr: UB-2025-00041) (henceforth referred to as Terms of publication).

The Author registers the relevant metadata (title, author, abstract, course etc) and uploads the Student thesis as a PDF to DiVA. Instructions are available here. The examining department is responsible to make sure the metadata is correct and publish the Student thesis when this Agreement has been signed. If associated collected data should be published, the Author register the data in Linköping University's student-community on Zenodo. Linköping University library will check its content and Metadata before publishing in Zenodo.
